- Architecture category - Full Cycle (2101 S. College Ave.), Vaught Frye Larson Architects; North Flats (Old Town North), Greg D. Fisher, Architect; Otterbox HQ (209 S. Meldrum St.), The Architects' Studio;
- Urban Fragment category - Equinox Brewing Beer Garden and Patio (133 Remington St.), Russell + Mills Studio; "Curtain" Illuminated Sculpture (Lincoln Center, 417 W. Magnolia St.), Barbara Baer; "Knowledge Shared" Sculptural Environment (Council Tree Library), Barbara Baer;
- Civic Improvement Project category - Downtown Alley Enhancement Project, Aller Lingle Massey Architects, Russell + Mills Studios;
